2017 Fall Conference News

Managerial/Sales attendees enjoyed a full-day seminar presented by renowned speaker Joe Ellers on *Outselling the Competition* and a half-day class on *Expanding Your Business Offerings into Motor Equipment Management* by Rick Hollen of Spring Point Solutions. Technical attendees were able to choose between two tracks: *Fundamentals of Pump Repair* presented by EASA Technical Support Specialist Gene Vogel; and *Ultrasound and Thermographic Testing of Electric Motors* by Don Donofrio of The Snell Group with Adrian Messer of UE Systems Inc. and *Energized and Non-Energized Motor Testing to ANSI Standards* by Don Donofrio.
