
# FLORIDA BECKONS YOU FOR THE 47TH FALL CONFERENCE

# EASA elects Darby president

E. Steve Darby, president of Darby Electric Co. in Anderson, has been installed as president of the Electrical Apparatus Service Association.

Darby, a native of Anderson, graduated from The Citadel.

He joined Darby Electric in 1962 and became president in 1974. The company, which rebuilds electrical motors, was founded in 1948 by Darby's father and two partners.

EASA, founded in 1933 and based in St. Louis, Mo., provides technical data on electric motor rebuilding to 2,700 members in 42 countries.

Darby was elected an international director in 1979 and has served as international secretary, treasurer and vice president. He is the first South Carolinian to be elected president.
