### EASA CODE OF BUSINESS PRACTICE

Amended June, 1982

Membership in EASA represents an obligation to the electrical industry and the public to maintain the highest quality of business integrity, electrical ability and service. Members should therefore, strictly conform to the following requirements:

1. A member shall be financially responsible. He shall be able to complete property and make good on his warranties on any job he may undertake.
2. A member shall adhere to any standards, warranties, or conditions which may be adopted by EASA. He shall honor any warranties he may make a customer. He shall not assume responsibilities which he cannot realistically fulfill with respect to warranties furnished or services rendered.
3. Members shall not make secret rebates or special terms to one purchaser which are not granted to all other purchasers in like circumstances.
4. A member shall not misrepresent his business, his products or his services.
5. A member shall show due consideration for other members and for their ability. He shall not attempt to harm another's business through misrepresentation or any other improper means which would cause loss of good will or reputation.
6. A member shall not initiate direct contact with employees of another EASA member with the objective of enticing them to terminate their present employment.
7. A member shall adequately provide for the well being of his employees. He shall carry Workman's Compensation Insurance as required by law. Public Liability Insurance and such other insurance as may be necessary for the proper protection of his employees and the public.
8. A member shall cooperate with fellow members to the best of his ability in sound and lawful projects or programs intended to improve the quality of the industry's service in the public interest.
9. In order to increase competition by avoiding "monopolies" of basic data required for servicing and repairing electrical equipment, all members will promptly make available to other such members, on request and upon payment of a charge not to exceed the reasonable cost of retrieving and providing such information, mechanical and winding data for electric motors, generators, transformers and similar equipment.
