*Full registrations include breakfast tickets. Use these to pay for your breakfast in the Delegal café. The tickets include 16% gratuity.

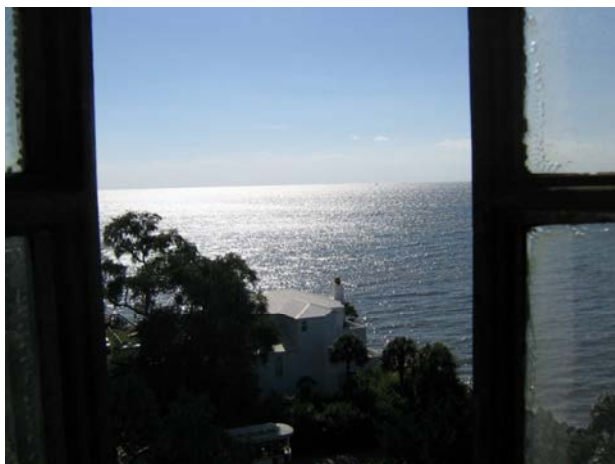
